## Academic Programme

### Early Years Curriculum

- The Reception classes follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum.
- Our Pre-primary programme is designed to lay foundation for the development of reading, writing and number work through structured play activities.
- SSGA, provides nurturing, creative and stimulating environment to develop the following skills in KG children:
  - ◆ Communication and Language : Listening, Attention and Understanding; Speaking
  - ◆ Personal, Social and Emotional Development: Self-Regulation; Managing Self; Building Relationships
  - ◆ Physical Development: Gross Motor Skills; Fine Motor Skills
  - ◆ Literacy: Comprehension; Word Reading; Writing
  - ◆ Mathematics: Number; Numerical Patterns
  - ◆ Understanding the World: People and their relationship and the Natural World
  - ◆ Expressive Arts and Design: Creating with Materials; Being Imaginative and Expressive

It stresses on providing first-hand experiences to children and ensure they are well equipped for entry to Year 1.



## Foundation stage – Key Stage 1

It includes children in Year 1 (UKG) and Year 2. (GRADE 1).

The school places a lot of emphasis on the early years because it recognises the value of providing appropriate care and stimulation for young children. It concentrates on the development of children's cognitive thinking and psychomotor skills through play-based, carefully supervised experimental, cooperative and reciprocal learning.

At the end of key stage 1, an internal assessment will be administered as a part of progression check.

The curriculum prepares children for a smooth transition to a more formal Primary curriculum through Integrated Learning.



## Key Stage 2

The Key stage 2 is designed for students of Year 4 – 6 (Grade 3, Grade 4, Grade 5)

At this stage the curriculum is designed to promote healthy study habits among the learners.

To build the necessary skills, we use a method of teaching and learning that is similar to a gear mechanism.

### Learning Gears at SSGA



At Key stage 2, learners' progress will be evaluated through regular Progression test assessed by the school, as well as internally benchmarked external assessment titled - Pearson Edexcel i Primary Achievement exam in Grade 5 level.

## Key Stage 3

The curriculum at KS3 is designed to prepare pupils of Years 7 to 9, (Grade 6; Grade 7; Grade 8) for further study in all the key areas at KS4 and beyond.

The methods used at this stage strengthens cognitive abilities such as pattern recognition, analysis, and problem solving, which help our students build higher order thinking and reasoning capabilities.

We emphasise techniques like learning by doing by way of projects, presentations, group discussions, debates etc; with the help of teachers. Besides these Music, Value education and physical education develop and groom learners aesthetically.

The IGCSE programme is initiated when the learners are in Grade 8 level, so as to give pace for the learners to take up the exams in two phases before they complete the Key stage 4.

The concepts in each subject stimulate, ignite and inspire students to access/build rich knowledge base for progression to KS4.

At this stage we focus more on creating interest, develop a challenging attitude alongside ensuring a deep understanding about the concepts.





## Key stage 4

In Key stage 4, students enter IGCSE Programme Year 10 and 11(Grade 9 & 10). Over these two years, subjects are dealt in more depth and will be utilised to be more focussed towards the Board Examination(IGCSE) preparation.

Edexcel IGCSE encourages learner centric, enquiry-based approach to learning. It enables schools to build a core curriculum and modify it to suit the needs of students by introducing cross-curricular perspectives. The programme's content and clearly defined learning outcomes enable IGCSE to be compatible with other curriculum across the world.

Edexcel IGCSE examination sessions occur twice a year, in May / June and October / November. Results are issued in August and January.

To recognize this great achievement, the Pearson Edexcel Board has bestowed him with the Outstanding Pearson Learner Award.

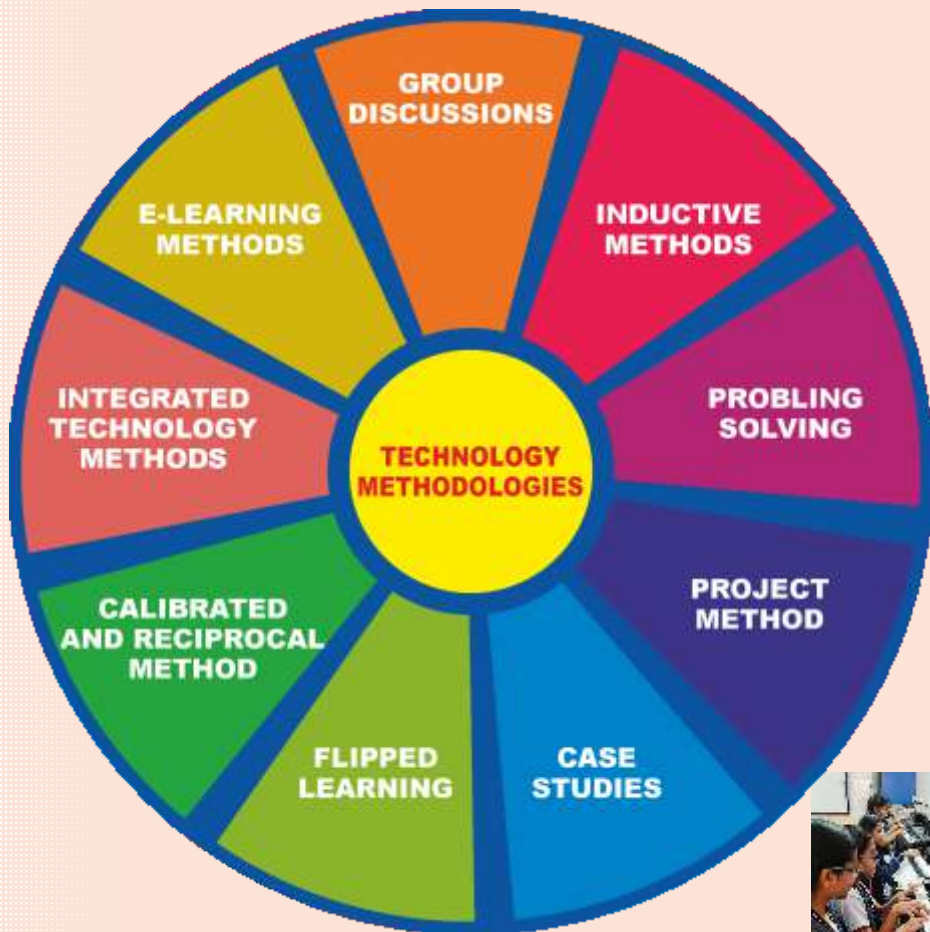
## IAL
